

Section 1: Assessment

Agricultural employers can use this checklist to create a COVID-19 assessment and control plan for applying specific preparation, prevention, and management measures. This checklist is based on guidance from the CDC and US DOL (<https://bit.ly/covid-ag-cdc-dol>). *Disclaimer*: Checklist is for reference only and does not guarantee compliance with state or local regulations.



- **Consider the characteristics of your region, worksite, space, and job tasks that may impact your assessment and control of COVID-19.**
- **Monitor federal, state, and local public health communications about COVID-19.**
 - 1. Ensure workers have access to current information.
 - 2. Check local public health information and the CDC COVID-19 website daily, or as needed depending on local conditions.
- **Designate a workplace coordinator responsible for COVID-19 assessment and control planning.**
 - 1. Ensure all workers know how to contact the coordinator.
 - 2. Ensure coordinator communicates in workers' preferred languages.
 - 3. Ensure coordinator provides materials at the appropriate literacy level.
- **Provide workers with information about where to get COVID-19 testing.**
- **Regularly conduct work site assessments to identify COVID-19 risks and prevention strategies.**

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
